- Blank fields until pre-market display. Selected fields will be cleared (resets at midnight) and will begin to update with pre-market activity.
- General widget settings: allows you to set preferences for behaviors for the entirety of the specified widget

 - Show study description in dialog: allows you to show or hide the study's description definition when the Studies Dialog is open

Regions Menu

The Regions Menu can be found on the upper right corner of a widget by the = icon.

Sort tabs: allows you to sort the order of the tabs in this region by A-Z or Z-A

Show region labels: this option only displays on the principal region. You can hide the principal region label to save space

Expand Region: allows you to make a region full screen and collapse it back into the workspace by either clicking "collapse region" in the region menu, the collapse icon in the upper righthand corner, or pressing the "Esc" key on your keyboard



Tab position: allows you to choose where to display the tab in relation to the widget:

Zoom region: allows you to enlarge or reduce the content of the widget by increments of 20%.



Create new region: allows you to create a new region in relation to your current widget:

- o On top
- On bottom
- To left
- To right

Move region

- New window: moves the selected region to a new browser window
- New Page: moves the selected region to a new page

Remove region: removes the region from your workspace, the removal will remove all tabs in the region

Set as principal region: allows you to set the selected region as the principal region, which is where all new widgets will open from the Widgets shortcuts on the toolbar

Pages can be found below the widget toolbar. Pages allow you to expand and organize your workspace as well as quickly switch between multiple workspaces.

Changing Pages: clicking on a page will open that page

Doubble click: double clicking on a page allow you to edit the name of the page

Widget Tabs

In each Region when multiple widgets are open you can toggle between the widget tabs to navigate between the widgets in that's region. Tabs can also be dragged and dropped within the region to rearrange their order, or to new or another existing region.



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Plus Icon: displays the launch menu, which allows you to open one of the listed widgets in that same region

Double Click: double clicking on a widget tab allows you to tear out the tab into its own window

Drag and Drop Tabs: clicking and holding allows you to drag tabs in the same region, across regions, and windows.

Linking:

Linking allows you to pass symbol between two or more widgets. This is controlled by selecting the Link Icon at the top left of the title bar. Note, you can also drag and drop symbols between widgets.



Link All: this will link your widget to all other widgets by default. This is the most common type of linking between widgets.

No Symbol Link: this will not link your widget to any widgets

Colors: this will allow you to isolate linkage to like colors without affecting other widget links, for example Green Watchlist to Green Chart

Broadcast: this will allow a symbol entered in this widget will be sent to all other widgets that are linked

Symbol Search Box: this is our symbol entry and symbol search entry point.

Typing in a symbol and hitting enter will return relevant information related to that symbol. Typing in an instrument description will allow you to view and choose potential matches to your text based on:

Chart All Icon: when this icon is enabled, symbols entered will overlay into your primary chart plot automatically into the existing scale.



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Clear Chart Icon: the trash icon will remove all secondary symbols, Studies and Drawing Tools that you've previously added, thereby resetting your Chart. Individual Studies can be deleted by clicking on the select Study and pressing the Delete key.

Add Icon: the add icon will allow you to overlay multiple symbols in a single chart window. In order that chart patterns can be compared more directly, the new symbol may also have its own scale.

Add Menu:

- Add to New Pane: adds symbol to a new Pane in existing window
- Add as Overlay: adds symbol to existing Pane using its own Scale
- Add to Existing Scale: adds symbol to existing pane using existing scale

Interval: this is a list intervals that define what each data point represents



Drawing Tools: this is a dropdown where you can find the right technical tool to better understand the technical patterns underlying the security.

A full list of Drawing tools can be found in the appendix here.



Studies: Each symbol and study has its own set of properties that can be modified. Certain symbol plot types (LINE and AREA charts) allow you to draw the symbol's plot based on a value other than the "Close." Some studies (such as, Bollinger Bands, Exponential Moving Average, and Momentum), perform their calculations using a specific value (Aspect) from the underlying data on which the study is applied. When the study is initially applied to a chart, it "binds" itself to this Aspect that is set in the study properties

- **How to insert:** click on the Studies button on the Chart toolbar, then select the appropriate study
- Change Chart Study Properties: right click on the study's pane or titlebar and select Object Properties to display its properties.
- Remove Study:
 - Right click and select Remove Study
 - Click on study and hit DELETE key
- Click on study and click on X icon on the top right corner of the study A full list of Studies can be found in the appendix here.



Flags: allows you to show certain corporate actions as icons in the Chart for any North American equity symbol in the shown timeframe in your Chart.



It only displays for Daily/weekly/Monthly intervals.

Templates: this allows you to customize and save and manage the details of a chart layout such as studies and tools

- **Display Preferences:** allows you to adjust display preferences that will apply to all Chart widgets
- **Slider:** the time scale on the bottom of the Chart



 Data View: allows you to display or remove a floating view of the selected symbol's Open/High/Low/Close and its volume as your mouse moves over the Chart



- **Snap:** By default, trendlines (for example, the **Lines** option in **Selection Tools**) snap to bar highs and lows when trendlines are added to a chart.

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- Snap to Studies: allows any trendlines to snap to lines or studies.
- **Show full precision:** expands the precision of the Volume field showing the complete number over an abbreviated display (for instance, 645m instead of 645,000,000)



- Grid: allows you to add or remove horizontal and or vertical grid lines

Remove [Symbol]: allows you to remove the selected symbol from Chart. This option only appears when right clicking the Chart Symbol Plot.

Hide [Symbol]: allows you to hide the selected symbol Plot from Chart, this is reversible by right clicking on the symbol header and selecting "Show [Symbol]". This option only appears when right clicking the Chart Symbol Plot.

Hide [Symbol] Value Marker: hides the value marker of the selected symbol on the price scale. This option only appears when right clicking the Chart Symbol Plot.

Bring [Symbol] to Front: allows you to highlight the selected symbol plot to the forefront of the Chart

- Lock scale: will fix the y-axis so that it does not move even if the price should move out of the visible part of the chart. This is useful if there is some horizontal element such as a stop limit that the user wants to remain in a fixed position
- **Percent:** divides the chart y-axis into 10% sections
- **Logarithmic:** divides the chart logarithmic scale (i.e. 1, 10, 100, 1000) which can aid visualization when the chart covers a large range of values

Export Data: allows you to export either all or just the visible data in your chart for your selected symbol into either ASCII text or Excel formats

Defaults: allows you to save and apply properties you've changed for your current Chart to other Chart widgets on a case by case basis

Display Preference: allows you to adjust display preferences that will apply to your current Chart widget

Net Order Imbalance: allows you to display the net order imbalance which includes the

following fields

- **Imbalance Side (Side)**: The Imbalance Side field indicates the market side for of the imbalance
 - Bid: buy-side imbalance
 - Sell: sell-side imbalance
 - **No Imb:** no imbalance (buy side equals sell side)
 - **O:** no marketable on-open (or on-close) orders in NASDAQ, thus no imbalance
- **Current Inside Match Price (CIMP):** The Current Inside Match Price reflects the price for which the number of Paired Shares and the number of Imbalance Shares are calculated. Please note that the Current Inside Match Price is determined by the price within the NASDAQ Inside where the maximum number of shares are paired, the imbalance is minimized and the distance from the bid-ask midpoint is minimized, in that order. If this field is null or blank, it is because there is no Current Inside Match Price for the specific security.
- Far Indicative Clearing Price (FICP): This field indicates the price level at which buy orders and sell orders match in the opening/ closing book. If this field is null or blank, this indicates one of two circumstances:

- There is no substantial on-open (or on-close) interest on the opposite side of the market to execute all of the MOO (or MOC) orders on the other side. When this occurs, the No Indicative Price field displays either a Market Buy or Market Sell indicating that offsetting imbalance only orders should be entered on the other side of the market.
- For the midday opening process, the Current Inside Match Price, the Near Indicative Clearing Price and the Far Indicative Clearing Price will be equal.
- **Near Indicative Clearing Price (NICP):** The crossing price at which orders in the NASDAQ opening/closing book and continuous book clear against each other. If this field is null or blank, this indicates one of two circumstances:
 - There are no on-open (or on-close) orders entered for the security; or
 - There is no substantial on-open (or on-close) or continuous book interest on the opposite side of the market to execute all of the MOO (or MOC) orders on the other side. When this occurs, the No Indicative Price field displays either a Market Buy or Market Sell indicating that offsetting imbalance-only or continuous market orders should be entered on the other side of the market.
 - For the midday opening process, the Current Inside Match Price, the Near Indicative Clearing Price and the Far Indicative Clearing Price will be equal.
- **Number of shares Paired (NSP):** The total number of shares that are eligible to be matched at the Current Inside Match Price.
 - For the Opening Cross, this calculation will include early "Regular Hours", Market On Open, Limit On Open, and Imbalance Only orders that are eligible to be matched at the Current Inside Match Price.
 - For the IPO and trading halt opening process, this calculation would include regular hour orders and quotes that are eligible to be matched at the Current Inside Match Price.
 - For the Closing Cross, this calculation will include Market On Close, Limit On Close, and Imbalance Only Orders that are eligible to be matched at the Current Inside Match Price.
 - The Number of Shares Paired may be zero-filled under the following two scenarios:
 - There are no on-open/on-close orders in the NASDAQ book. In this case, the Imbalance Side field would be set to "O".
 - There are no shares in the eligible order types that match at the Current Inside Match Price

- **No Indicative Clearing Price (cNOICP)**: indicator when one of the sides doesn't have a price

 - For the opening and closing crosses, the Number of Shares of Imbalance may be zero-filled under the following scenarios:
 - There are no on-open/on-close orders in the NASDAQ book. In this case, the Imbalance Side field would be set to "O".
 - There is no imbalance; all shares in eligible orders can be paired at current inside match price. In this case, the Imbalance Side would be set to "NoImb".

List of Drawing Tools:

Selection Tool: the default, it's a cursor for clicking on the chart for data

Measure Tool: measures the distance between 2 data points, the price, percent, dollar change (missing decimal point), number of bars and numbers of days difference will be calculated and displayed



Line: Lines are used to mark the trends in which markets are moving.



Level Line: Level Lines, as the name implies are absolutely flat and can be used to mark thresholds of price and other values.



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Vertical Line: vertical lines can be used to mark thresholds of time

Ray: A ray is used to mark the trends in which markets are moving. The difference between a line and a ray is that a ray has two pivot points, and automatically extends indefinitely to the right.



Andrew's Pitchfork: Andrew's Pitchfork is a technical indicator that uses three parallel trend lines to identify possible levels of support and resistance as well as potential breakout and breakdown levels. The indicator, developed by Alan Andrews, uses trend lines that are created by selecting three points at the start of confirmed trends, higher or lower. This is achieved by placing the points at three consecutive peaks and troughs. Once the points are in place, a straight line that denotes the "median line" is drawn from the first point through the midpoint between the upper and lower points. Upper and lower trend lines are then drawn parallel to the median line



Channel

Text: allows for text box to appear wherever you click on the Chart



Up Arrow Callout: a up arrow icon you can place on the Chart by left clicking



Down Arrow Callout: a down arrow icon you can place on the Chart by left clicking



Gann Fan: A Gann Fan is drawn between a significant bottom and top (or vice versa) at various angles.



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Up Gann Fan: A Gann Fan is drawn between a significant bottom and top (or vice versa) at upward angles.



Down Gann Fan: A Gann Fan is drawn between a significant bottom and top (or vice versa) at downward angles.



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Fibonacci Fan: Fibonacci Fan is displayed by drawing a trendline between two reference or extreme points on the chart (usually a trough and opposing peak). Next, an invisible vertical line is drawn through the second reference point. Three trendlines are then drawn from the first extreme point so they pass through the invisible vertical line at the Fibonacci levels of 38.2%, 50.0%, and 61.8%.



Fibonacci Arc: The Fibonacci Arc is drawn by placing a trendline between two extreme points (usually a trough and opposing peak). The radius of the arcs can be increased by pulling the control line End Point (Ending Price x time) away from the Beginning Point (Beginning Price x time).



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Fibonacci Retracement: Fibonacci Retracements are displayed by drawing a trendline between two reference or extreme points on the chart (usually a trough and opposing peak). Next, a series of nine horizontal lines are drawn. The lines intersect the trendline between the two reference points at the Fibonacci levels of 0.0%, 23.6%, 38.2%, 50.0%, 61.8%, 100.0%, 161.8%, 261.8%, and 4236%. Some of the lines might not be visible, because of the scale limitations in the chart window.



Fibonacci Extension: Fibonacci Extensions are similar to Retracements, except that they extend clear to one side of the chart of the chart and beyond. As with many of the other Fibonacci Tools a green control line is used to set the location, height and width of the Extension.



Speed Resistance Fan: The Speed Resistance Fan displays three trendlines, sometimes referred to as 1/3-2/3 lines. These trendlines divide a price move into three equal sections.


Speed Resistance Arc: he Speed Resistance Arc display three arcs, sometimes referred to as 1/3-2/3 arcs. These arcs divide a price move into three equal sections.



Rectangle: The rectangle is a non-analytical drawing object used to highlight or bring attention to a group of bars or a particular section in a chart.



Ellipse: The ellipse is a non-analytical drawing object used to highlight or bring attention to a group of bars or a particular section in a chart.



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Cycle Tool: The Cycle tool allows the user to specify a period of bars and then strips the chart so that patterns can be discerned



Show in News: allows you to highlight a timeframe of your symbol and view in the News widget with stories filtered to the timeframe you'd highlight on the Chart widget



List of Studies:

Accumulation/Distribution Line: a technical indicator that plots changes in the value of the advance-decline index over a certain time period. Each point on the chart is calculated by taking the difference between the number of advancing/declining issues and adding the results to the previous period's value



Average True Range: specifies the degree of price volatility of a security. The average true range is an n-day exponential moving average of the true range values



Bollinger Bands: Bollinger Bands is a technical analysis tool invented by John Bollinger in the 1980s, and a term trademarked by him in 2011. Evolving from the concept of trading bands, Bollinger bands and the related indicators %b and bandwidth can be used to measure the 'highness' or 'lowness' of the price relative to previous trades. Bollinger bands are an indicator of volatility.



Chaikin Volatility: compares the spread between a securities's high and low prices, quantifying volatility as a widening of the range between the high and the low price.

 High values indicate that intraday prices have a wide high-to-low range. Low values indicate that intraday prices have relatively constant high-tolow range

- Market tops that are accompanied by increased volatility over short periods of time indicate nervous and indecisive traders. Market tops with decreasing volatility over long timeframes indicate maturing bull markets
- Market bottoms that are accompanied by decreased volatility over long periods of time indicated bored and disinterested traders. Market bottoms with increasing volatility over relatively short time periods indicate panic sell-offs.



Choppiness: a function of market direction. A market that is trending has a low choppiness number while a trend less market has a high choppiness number



Commodity Channel Index: designed to detect beginning and ending market trends. This study measures the distance between the share prices and their moving average, and thus allows a measurement for the trend strength and/or intensity



Directional Movement Index: plotted as three lines on a scale of 0 to 100. This scale is a measure of market trend. The two lines of DMI show the amount of positive and negative movement. The positive line is called D+ and the negative D-. The third line is based on the average directional index (ADX).



Elder Force Index: the force index is an indicator that uses price and volume to assess the power behind a move or identify possible turning points.



Envelope: a derivative of the moving average study. The price band has two lines that are equal percentage distance from the simple moving average. The moving average line is not visible.



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Exponential Moving Average: similar to the simple moving average except a weighting is applied to the price data as the average is calculated thus removing short-term fluctuations and leaves to view the prevailing trend.



Exponential Oscillator: a histogram, using the difference between two moving averages. Used to help identify divergences, short-term variations from the longterm trend, and to identify the crossing of two moving averages, which occur when the oscillator crosses the zero line.



Highest High Lowest Low: an envelope of values by using the highest high or the lowest low of the last n periods.



High Low Moving Average: a simple moving average of the high and low for the specified interval. The length of the moving average can vary for the high and low.



Historic Volatility: the degree of movement in a market for a given period over a specified time span.



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Keitner Channel: an n-day moving average plotted with a channel formed by adding and subtracting an n-bar moving average of the high-low range to or from the moving average. The width of the channel adjusts to market volatility.



MACD: calculates moving averages that can monitor and signal trends. It is both a trend following indicator as well as an oscillator.



Mass Index: mass index is a form of technical analysis that examines the range between high and low stock prices over a period of time. Mass index suggests that a reversal of the current trend will likely take place when the range widens beyond a certain point and then contracts.



Momentum: calculates the continuous difference between two prices at fixed intervals of time



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Moving Average: the average value of a security's price over a set period. Generally used to measure momentum and define areas of possible support and resistance.



Money Flow Index: a momentum indicator that measures the strength of money flowing in and out of a security. Related to the relative strength index (RSI) but whereas the RSI incorporates only prices, the MFI also accounts for volume.



On Balance Volume: the continuous consecutive sum of volumes, whereby the entire volume of a day is added or subtracted to the volume of the previous day's OBV, if today's closing prices is above or below that of yesterday, respectively. Unchanged closing prices have no effect on the OBV.



Oscillator: the arithmetic difference between two simple moving averages of differing time periods.



Parabolic Stop and Reversal: the study continuously computes 'stop and reverse' price points. Whenever the market penetrates this 'stop and reverse' point, you liquidate your current position and take the opposite position.





Previous Close: displays the closing price of the previous trading day.

Price Channel: price channels are lines set above and below the price of a security. The upper channel is set at the x-period high and the lower channel is set at the x-period low. For a 20-day price channel, the upper channel would equal the 20-day high and the lower channel would equal the 20-day low.





Rate of Change: the percentage change in price over the last n periods

Relative Strength Index: the internal strength of an instrument as compared to former prices over a specified period of time



Slow Stochastic: an oscillator, smoothed using a moving average, designed to indicate oversold and overbought market conditions.



Smoothed Moving Average: an exponential moving average of which a longer period is applied to further smooth the curve



Standard Deviation (Volatility): standard deviation is a statistical term that measures the amount of variability or dispersion around an average. Standard deviation is also a measure of volatility. Generally speaking, dispersion is the difference between the actual value and the average value. The larger this dispersion or variability is, the higher the standard deviation. The smaller this dispersion or variability is, the lower the standard deviation. Standard deviation can be used to measure expected risk and determine the significance of certain price movements.



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Stochastic: compares the difference between the closing trade price of an instrument and the period low, relative to the trading range over an observation time period





Ultimate Oscillator: compares the instrument's price with its price x-periods ago

Variable Moving Average: a combination of the normal moving average, the exponential moving average and the smoothed moving average.



Volume: the magnitude of units (shares, contracts, etc.) executed during a specified time period.



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Volume Accumulation: the volume accumulation indicator combines volume and price-weighting that attempts to show the strength of conviction behind a trend; the volume accumulation indicator might prove useful in uncovering divergences.





Volume at Price: displays cumulative volume at price points.

Weighted Moving Average: designed to give the current or the recent price more weight than the previous prices



William's %R: the difference between the period high and today's closing price with the trading range of the specified period.
